Public transport

Public transport allows you to access the campus by means of various combinations of bus, train and/or underground, depending on your place of departure. The timetables should be checked regularly, as they change at the weekends, during school breaks and in summer.



Bus

You can use the bus number 19 to get to the campus from various locations in Palma.

There are also inter-urban buses that run between some towns and the campus: Lines L200 (Estellencs - Esporles – Palma) and L210 (Sóller - Valldemossa - Palma).



Underground

The M1 metro line links the centre of Palma to the campus.



Train

There are different train lines (Inca, Sa Pobla, Manacor) and Sóller Train allow combinations with other means of transport in order to reach the campus. They all terminate at “Plaza de España” in Palma.

Private Transport



Car

The University can be accessed by car through three entrances. Two of them are located in the “carretera de Valldemossa”, one near “Son Lledó” building and the other near University School of Hotel Management. The other entrance is located in the “carretera del ParcBIT”, near the Anselm Turmeda Building.



Bicycle

There is a bicycle lane from the centre of Palma to the UIB campus.
